## *Hobcaw Barony*

On **April 25**, we will meet at Hobcaw Barony in Georgetown at 1:00 pm for a two-hour **tour of Bellefield Plantation**. Hobcaw Barony is a 16,000 acre research reserve. It is one of the few underdeveloped tracts on the Waccamaw Neck. The **Bellefield Plantation Tour** takes place on the grounds of Bellefield Plantation, the home of Belle Baruch, daughter of Bernard and Anne Baruch. Belle built her permanent home in what she called the "friendliest woods in the world." As the house stands empty and awaits restoration, these tours provide a chance to walk the grounds, see the stables, kennels, garage and gardens of a once stately home as well as step inside the house to understand Belle's simple lifestyle and her love of the Lowcountry .
